Legends & Heroes Tour Invited to The 2012 Toyota – JGRMX Tacoma Video Shoot!

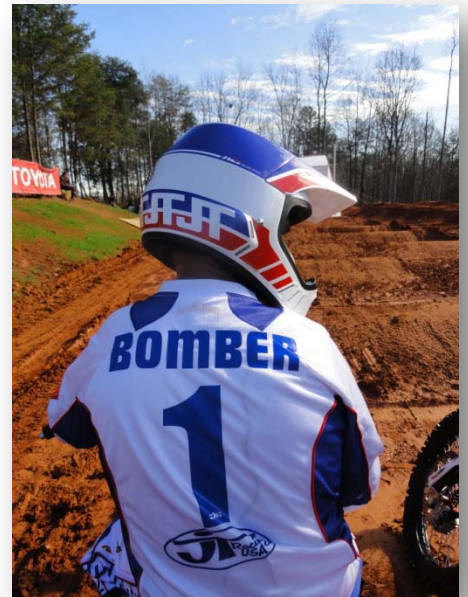
